


AUGER MOTOR REPLACEMENT



TOOLS YOU'LL NEED

5/16" SOCKET | SMALL SOCKET EXTENSION | RATCHET | 3/16" HEX KEY | 5/32" HEX KEY









CAUTION: BEFORE BEGINNING THIS PROCEDURE, ENSURE THAT THE POWER CORD TO THE SMOKER IS DISCONNECTED! FAILING TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN BODILY INJURY.

COMPETITION CART MODELS REQUIRE UNPLUGGING THE POWER CORD FROM THE HOPPER LOCATED UNDER THE CART.




1. Remove the end panel by removing the eleven self-drilling screws using the 5/16" socket to gain access into the hopper.

2. Disconnect the two wires (one green, one white) from the outer fan. (Comp cart/ACS models: Disconnect the purple wires from the the end panel.)



3. Disconnect the black and red wire from the auger motor.






4. Remove the 2 bolts securing the auger motor using the 3/16" hex key and 5/32" hex key. Then remove the auger motor from the hopper.

5. On the new auger motor assembly, remove the 5/32" bolt.




6. Insert the auger motor assembly into the tube and screw the two bolts into the motor. Start the bolts by hand first, then tighten the 3/16" bolt first.






7. Connect the black and red wire to the auger motor.

8. Attach the green and white wire to the outer fan. (Comp cart/ACS models: Attach the purple wires from the the end panel.)



9. Ensure all wires are free of both fans. Lastly, attach the end panel to the hopper using the eleven self-drilling screws.
